During this time he managed many of the area's historical projects and was involved in several archaeological excavations.





Port Macquarie's history & archaeology

Port Macquarie, the traditional country of the Birpai, has a fascinating past since those days, back in 1821, when it was founded by the British as a penal settlement.

This tour provides a general introduction to Port Macquarie and there is no better way to appreciate the town's history than on foot. Listen to the stories, visit some of our historical sites and see how our history is being interpreted.


